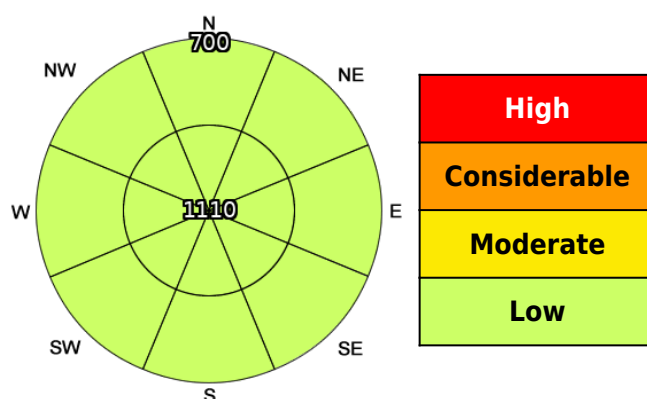


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 07/02/2025****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Little change expected. The snowpack will be patchy and generally well consolidated with good stability throughout. Limited snow cover below 700 metres with much bare ground around the summits. Most snow exists in high North through East to South-East aspects and will remain firm in many locations. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will be a dry day with good periods of sunshine. The strong South-West wind will slowly moderate through the period, gradually backing to the East. The freezing level will be at summit level initially, gradually lowering to around 500 metres during the day.

Comments

Settled conditions expected to continue with snow cover gradually depleting. Expect a high windchill on exposed summits.
