

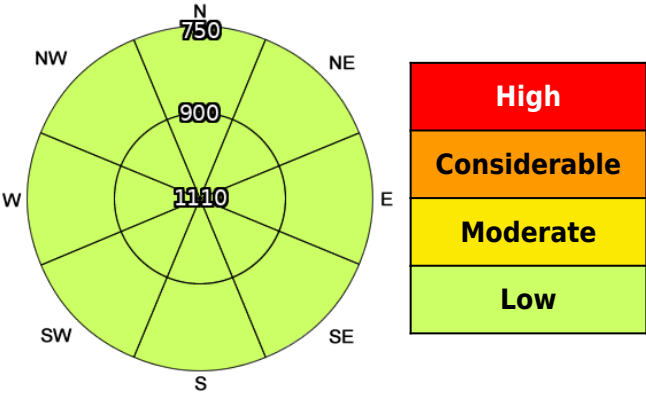

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The patchy snow cover will remain firm and stable in all locations. Greatest snow cover will be mostly in mountain areas inland from the coastal ranges and on Northerly to Easterly aspects above 750 metres. Snow will be mainly confined to coire rims, ridge flanks and gullies. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will be dry and cloudy throughout the period. Strong Easterly or South-Easterly winds will steadily decrease through the day becoming fresh to moderate. The overnight freezing level will be around 400 metres, rising to around 600 metres during the day.

Comments

Continuing to feel cold in higher wind exposed areas. Some paths at higher elevations remain icy in places.
