

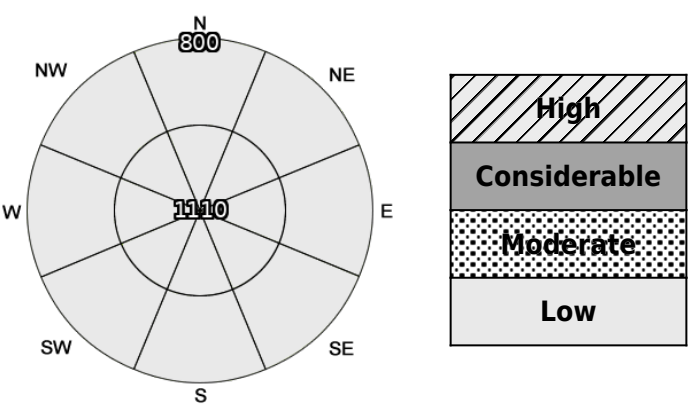

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 23/02/2025

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change expected. The moist snow cover will be patchy, thawing at all levels and stable throughout. Most snow will remain above 800 metres on North to East aspects, notably on mountains away from the coastal fringe. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Generally dry overnight, but during the day, there will be heavy rain at all levels accompanied with storm force Southerly winds. The freezing level will rise well above the summits with the arrival of the rain.

Comments

A wet and stormy day tomorrow. The limited and patchy snow cover will further diminish. Colder into next week and winds easing.
