

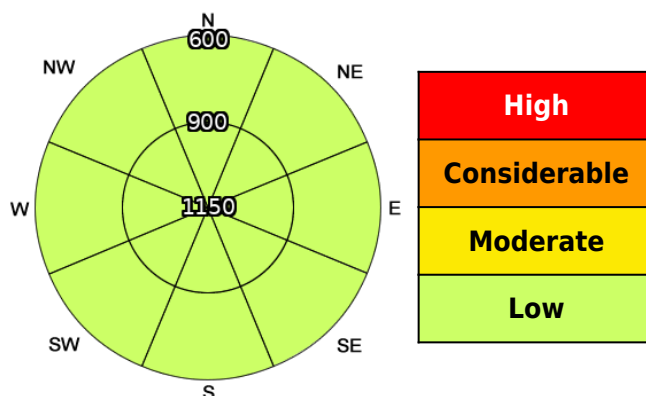

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 01/03/2025

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected. The snowpack will remain very firm and stable throughout with a thin cover of snow in places. Greatest amounts will be found above 900m and mostly confined to steep shady areas in gullies and coire headwalls on mostly North-West to North-Easterly aspects. Other aspects are generally clear of snow with hard firm patches in hollows and other wind sheltered places. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

A dry day with no precipitation expected. Freezing level around 600 m rising to summit levels later in the afternoon. Winds, very strong South-Westerlies overnight easing during the day as the wind veers Westerly.

Cold and wintry scenery above 900m in N facing coires.
