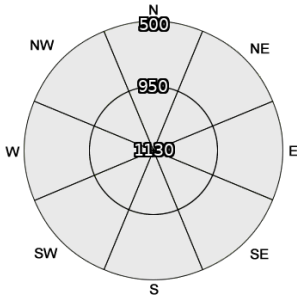


Avalanche Hazard Forecast - FOR PERIOD 18:00HRS Thu 13/03/2025 TO 18:00HRS Fri 14/03/2025



Hazard Level	Avalanche Probability
Very High	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. Numerous very large, often extremely large natural avalanches can be expected.
High	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. In some cases, numerous large, often very large sized natural avalanches can be expected.
Considerable	Natural and human triggered avalanches possible, in some cases large, in isolated cases very large sized natural avalanches are possible.
Moderate	Very large sized natural avalanches are unlikely. Human triggering possible in indicated steep places.
Low	Only small and medium sized natural avalanches are possible. Human triggering possible in steep, extreme terrain.

Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, showers falling as snow above 500 metres, dry thereafter. Fresh, North-West winds initially, veering North-Easterly through the night and decreasing to become light by the end of the forecasting period. The freezing level will drop to around 500 metres overnight and then rise steadily to 800 metres during the day.

Forecast Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

There will be fresh snow above 500 metres although quantities are not expected to be significant. The old patchy snowpack will be firm and stable in all locations and will be mostly confined to steep North to East aspects above 950 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

Observed Avalanche Hazard - Thu 13/03/2025

Observed Weather Influences

A mostly dry day with moderate Northerly winds. The freezing level was around 650 metres.

Observed Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

There is a light dusting of fresh snow above 700 metres. The old patchy snowpack is firm and stable in all locations being mostly confined to steep North to East aspects above 950m. The avalanche hazard is Low.

Mountain Conditions

Observed Mountain Travel Conditions

Sparse snow cover mostly bare ground. Winds approx 10 - 20 mph fresh, cooling. Good visibility.

Comments

The hills will look wintry with fresh snow overnight but this will be mostly superficial.
