

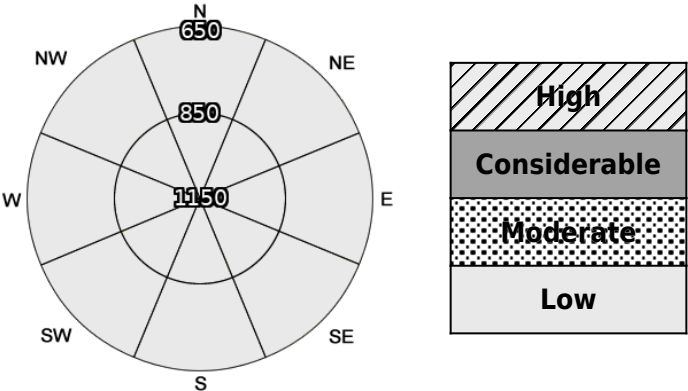

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 15/03/2025

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The recent dusting of new snow is not significant and will dissipate and reduce further, some shallow new snow areas will remain at higher elevations. The older snow patches will still exist on North to Easterly aspects above 850 metres particularly in sheltered hollows, gullies and steep coire rims. These deposits will be frozen, firm and often icy. Snow stability will be good in all locations. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

A ridge of high pressure will bring dry and settled conditions to the area. The overnight freezing level will rise from 600 metres to around 900 metres by the end of the day. The light North-Easterly winds will veer, strengthen slightly becoming most West-North-Westerly.

Comments

Remaining mainly dry and slightly warmer. Isolated light showers possible on Sunday.
