

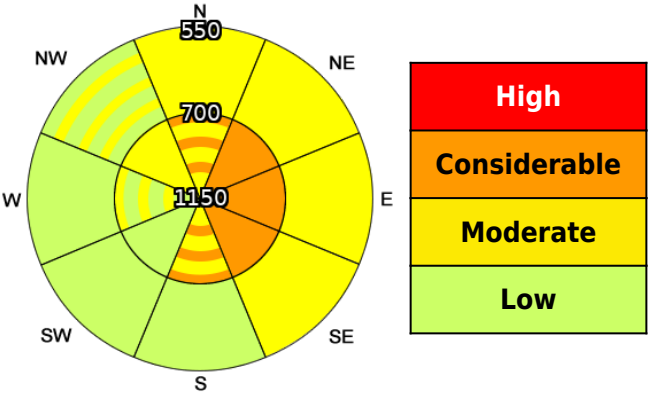

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 15/03/2025

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The general thin covering of snow will thaw at lower altitudes and where situated in direct sunlight. Limited accumulations of moderately bonded windslab may be encountered in steeper wind sheltered locations on South-East to South-West aspects above 1000 metres. These will be limited in distribution and generally avoidable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

No precipitation has been forecast. Northerly winds backing North-Westerly later, moderate strength. 500 metre freezing level overnight, rising to 1000 metres by the end of the period.

Comments

Felt wintery on the tops today. A ridge of high pressure brining better conditions for Saturday.
