

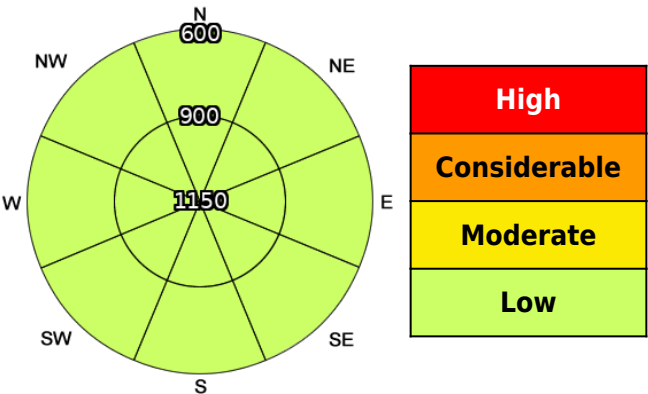

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 17/03/2025

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The remaining snow will firm up overnight before gradually softening again during the day. There will be a steady reduction in the superficial snow cover at lower elevations. Firmer, old snow will be present in steeper, wind sheltered locations on North-West to North-East aspects above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

No precipitation forecast. Fresh North-Easterly winds overnight, veering South-South-Easterly and easing to moderate during the day. 650 metre freezing level overnight, gradually rising to 1200 metres by the end of the afternoon.

Comments

High pressure maintaining settled conditions for the start of the week. Milder weather arriving on Thursday.
