

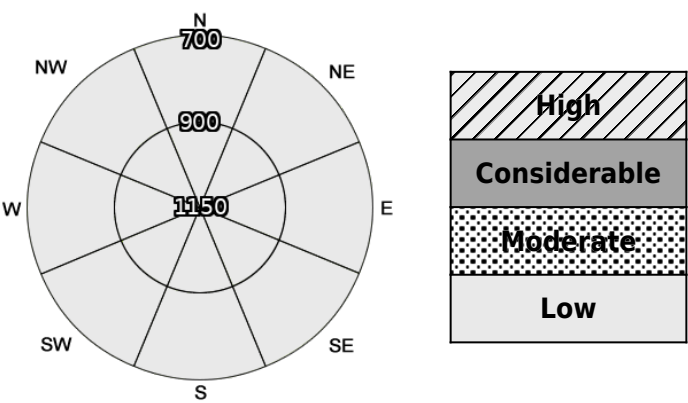

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 24/03/2025

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The remaining snow patches will continue to thaw but will be well bonded and stable in all locations. Many areas will be free from snow. Larger areas will be encountered on the higher mountains along the northern boundary of the forecast area and in the steep, shady North-West to North-East facing corries above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

No precipitation is forecast. Light to moderate variable winds overnight will gradually increase in strength, to become strong West-South-Westerly by the end of the period. The freezing level will rise well above the summits during the day.
