#### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 25/11/2025



##### Avalanche Problems

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised windslab will be present above 900 metres on South-East to South-Westerly aspects, Coire rims and gully tops most affected. Elsewhere the moist snowpack will refreeze and will be firm and stable throughout. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



##### Forecast Weather Influences

Freezing level falling from 1000m during the evening then to 800m overnight, then at 5-600m during the day. Snow showers dying out overnight clearing by morning, a mostly dry day is expected. Winds generally moderate to light North-Westerly overnight becoming light and variable during the day.

##### Comments

A clear and cold day in prospect for Tuesday, poor viz and mild Wednesday.
