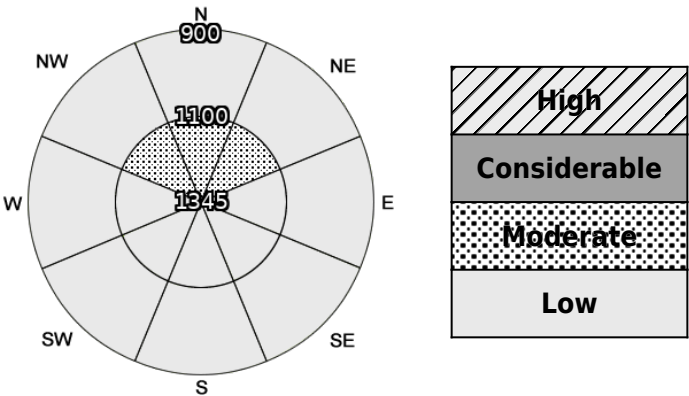
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh deposits of poorly bonded windslab will accumulate overnight on North-West to North-East aspects above 1100 meters. These instabilities are expected to be localised affecting wind sheltered locations such as corrie headwalls and the tops of gullies. On other aspects and at lower elevations the snowpack will be generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, Storm Force South-South-East winds, easing to moderate strength and veering to a South-South-Westerly during the day. Overnight precipitation is expected, falling as snow above 900 meters. The freezing level will rise to summit level during the day.

Comments

A stunning day, with great views. Snow cover on all aspects above 900m, very hard and icy. Slip hazard with very consequential runouts.
