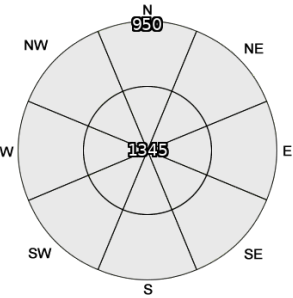


Avalanche Hazard Forecast - FOR PERIOD 18:00HRS Sat 06/12/2025 TO 18:00HRS Sun 07/12/2025



Hazard Level	Avalanche Probability
Very High	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. Numerous very large, often extremely large natural avalanches can be expected.
High	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. In some cases, numerous large, often very large sized natural avalanches can be expected.
Considerable	Natural and human triggered avalanches possible, in some cases large, in isolated cases very large sized natural avalanches are possible.
Moderate	Very large sized natural avalanches are unlikely. Human triggering possible in indicated steep places.
Low	Only small and medium sized natural avalanches are possible. Human triggering possible in steep, extreme terrain.

Forecast Weather Influences

After a dry night and morning, some rain is expected in the afternoon. The freezing level will be above the summits. Winds will be from the South-East.

Forecast Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate in the mild conditions. Stability will generally be good. However, some small cornices exist on North to East aspects above 1100 metres, and these will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

Observed Avalanche Hazard - Sat 06/12/2025

Observed Weather Influences

After some overnight snow accompanied by strong South-Easterly winds it was a generally dry but cloudy day with light winds. The freezing level rose above the summits through the morning.

Observed Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack is starting to slowly thaw and consolidate in the settled conditions. Areas of windslab exist on sheltered North-West to North-East aspects above 1100 metres. However, these are not extensive and are reasonably well bonded. On other aspects, and at lower levels, the snowpack is very shallow. The avalanche hazard is Low.

Mountain Conditions

Observed Mountain Travel Conditions	Main snowpack found above 950 metres, not much below this level. Poor visibility throughout the day on the tops. After a windy night it was generally quite a calm day.
Comments	Slightly colder conditions expected on Monday before turning mild again on Tuesday.
