



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh snow accumulations are expected to be insignificant. This will be insufficient to warrant an avalanche hazard category. For further information please refer to the SAIS mountain blog.





Forecast Weather Influences

In the evening there will be storm force South-Westerly winds, rain at all elevations and the freezing level will be above the summits. During the night the freezing level drops to around 1000 metres, winds ease to strong South-Westerlies and precipitation becomes occasional showers falling as snow above 900 metres. These conditions continue through the day.

Comments

Only a dusting of snow on the higher tops is expected and this will mainly lie on bare ground.
