
Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some additional new thin windslab is possible at the top of very steep North to East aspects above 1000m. Some very minor wet snow instability is possible here with the onset of much milder and wet conditions later in the morning. Superficial snow cover at lower elevations expected to deplete rapidly during the meltdown. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

A few overnight snow showers on South West winds then dry for a time. Rain, preceded by some snow showers, commencing in the morning. Cold overnight but freezing level rising to 2000m by midday.

Comments

Slightly more snow at the western end of our area on Tuesday. Only limited wet snow instability expected with the onset of mild and wet weather on Weds morning. Significant snow loss anticipated at all levels by the end of the day.
