




Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

All recent deposits will slowly thaw in the milder conditions but will remain generally stable. Greatest amounts of snow will be encountered in wind sheltered locations, such as gully tops and around corrie rims on North to East aspects above 950 metres. The small cornices that are present above some slopes on these aspects may be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.





Forecast Weather Influences

There will be some light rain during the morning, followed by a dry afternoon. Strong Easterly winds will veer South-Easterly. The freezing level will be above all summits for the duration of the period.
