

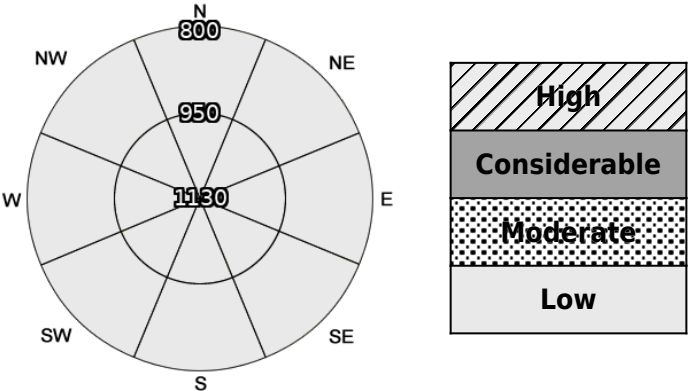

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The remaining snowpack will be firm and stable. It lies mainly around coire rims, on steep upper slopes and at the tops of gullies above 950 metres on North to East aspects. The greatest extent lies around Coire Ardair. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain dry, with light to moderate generally East-South-East winds. A complex temperature inversion around the summits will create a unclear freezing level though generally around 800 metres.

Comments

The remaining snow is firm and has serious run outs with potentially serious consequences.
