


### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 28/12/2025

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The remaining snow will be firm and stable. It lies mainly around coire rims, on steep upper slopes and at the tops of some gullies above 850 metres on North to East aspects. The greatest extent lies in the Northern Fannaichs. The firm snow will have serious run outs with potentially serious consequences in the event of a slip or trip. There is insufficient snow to warrant issuing an avalanche hazard category.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain dry. Overnight moderate to strong Easterly winds are expected to veer South-Westerly and ease, to be very light and variable during the day. The dry air means the effective freezing level will be around 400 metres.

#### Comments

Although limited in extent the remaining snow will be firm and will have serious run outs with potentially serious consequences in the event of a slip or trip.
