

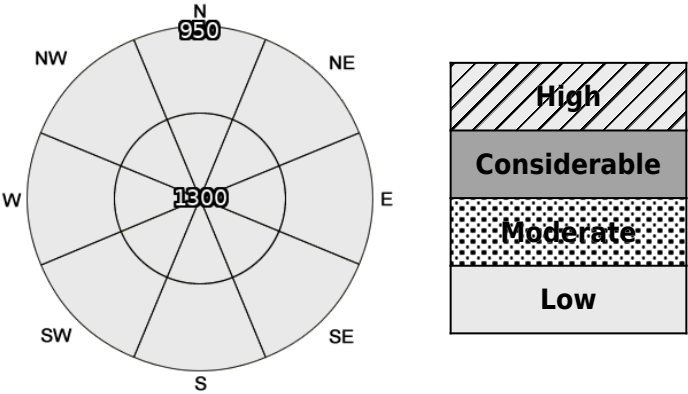

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 29/12/2025

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change expected. The existing snowpack will remain firm with good stability in all locations. The greatest areas of snow will be confined to coire back walls, coire rims, and on high plateaus on North to East aspects above 950 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

High pressure continues to dominate. Strong Northerly winds. The possibility of a very light snow shower mid-morning. Variable freezing level overnight but expected to lower to 600 meters during the afternoon.

Comments

A day of poor visibility on the tops forecast for Monday. The remaining snow patches present a very serious slip hazard with very consequential run outs.
