

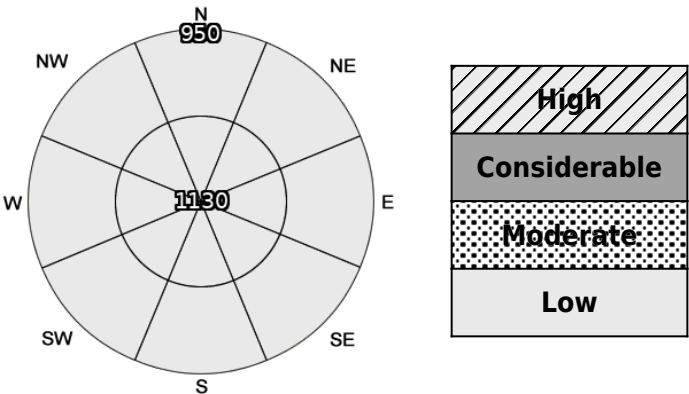

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 29/12/2025

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

No significant change is expected with the remaining snowpack being firm and stable throughout. Snow lies mainly around coire rims, on steep upper slopes and at the tops of gullies above 950 metres on North to East aspects. The greatest extent is around Coire Ardair and on Creag Meagaidh plateau. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry throughout with North-Easterly winds, initially light, increasing overnight to become fresh. The freezing level will drop to be around 600 metres by the end of the forecasting period.

Comments

There will be patches of bullet hard water ice on some footpaths and hillsides.
