


Avalanche Hazard Forecast


Little change, the remaining patchy snowpack will remain frozen, well bonded, firm and stable, the greatest areas will be above 950 metres. These patchy accumulations will mainly exist in sheltered gullies and hollows on North to East aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Low

**Forecast Weather Influences**

High pressure will continue to affect the area, it is expected to remain cold and dry throughout the period. The freezing level will lower to around 550 metres by dawn and remain so through the day. The moderate to fresh Easterly winds will ease and veer through South in the morning becoming West-South- West by the end of the day.

Comments

High pressure slips away during Wednesday allowing a showery North-Westerly to develop. Maybe new snow will arrive for new year.
