

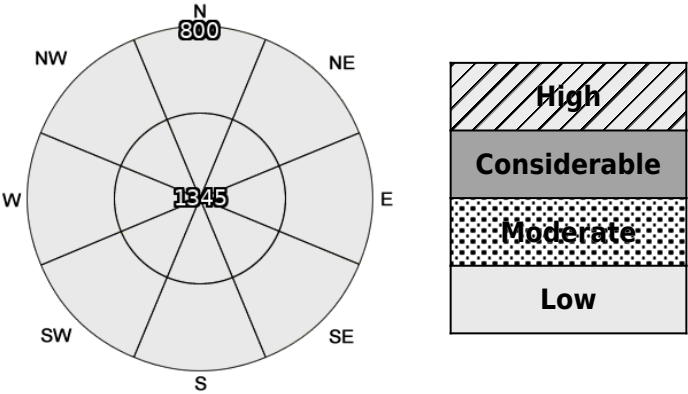

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 31/12/2025

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain firm and stable. Fresh snow accumulations are not expected to be significant. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light winds overnight increase through the day to become strong West-South-Westerlies. Mainly dry with some precipitation in the afternoon falling as snow above 800 metres. The freezing level will rise through the period to around 900 metres.

Comments

The firm snow continues to present serious consequences in the event of slips, trips or falls. Some snow forecast over the next few days although how much reaches Lochaber remains to be seen.
