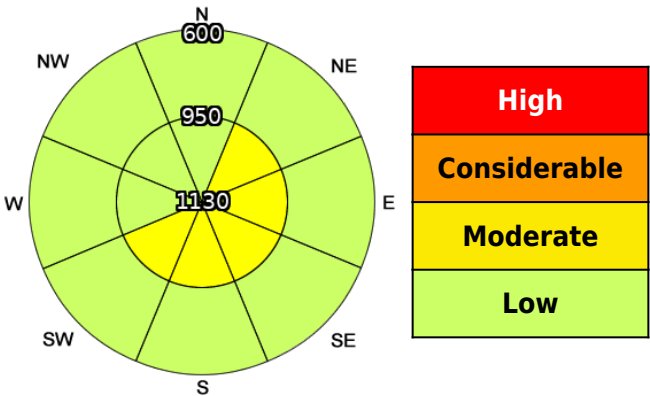

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh unstable windslab will be deposited throughout the period. Deposits will become more widespread as the day progresses, being mostly found on steep North-East through East to South aspects above 950 metres. Some redistribution of snow will occur resulting in localised cross loaded deposits on South-West aspects. Elsewhere, a covering of snow will be present on all aspects from the glens upwards. Cornices are expected to develop throughout the period. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers are expected throughout the period on very strong North-North-Westerly winds. The freezing level will fluctuate around 100 metres.
