






Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will become deeper and more widespread with avalanches likely on North through East to South aspects mainly above 800 metres, more localised below this altitude on steep banks and burn lines. Localised instabilities will be present due to cross loading on South-West to North-West aspects above 800 metres. Fragile cornices will continue to develop. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snowfall is expected throughout the forecast period. Winds will mostly be North-Westerly in direction, strong to gale force overnight, easing fresh to moderate through the day. Initially freezing at 600 metres before falling to 400 metres.
