

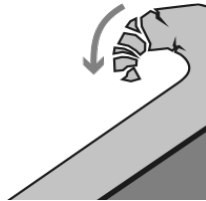

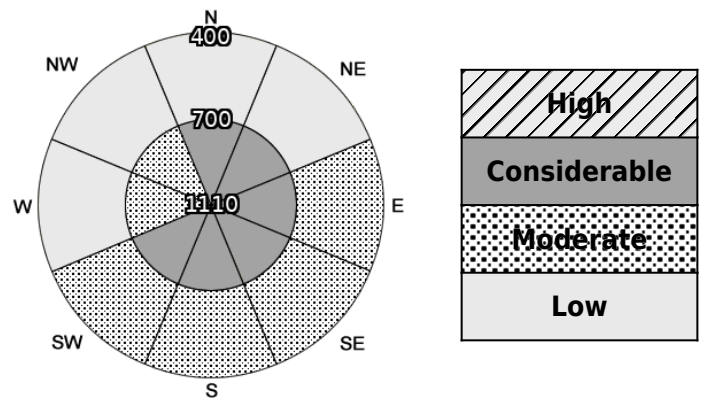
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Weaknesses will persist in the recently deposited windslab, greatest accumulations of which lie on North-East through East and South to South-West aspects above 700 metres. Some new unstable windslab will be deposited in wind sheltered areas, mainly on North-West to North-East aspects above 800 metres. Fragile cornices will remain, especially over East through South to South-West aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be fresh generally Southerly. After a dry evening light precipitation is expected throughout the rest of the period, falling as snow above around 300 metres. The freezing level will rise to be 400 to 500 metres during the day.

Comments

Deep snow at all levels making the going very hard on foot.
