




Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 13/01/2026

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Remaining snow will initially be wet and soft but generally well bonded in all locations. As the freezing level drops existing snow will become firmer, particularly at higher levels. Any new snowfall is expected to be very light and inconsequential. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

A return to cooler conditions with the freezing level dropping to around 600 metres. Dry in the morning with light snow showers in early afternoon. Winds will initially be from the North but will back and strengthen; fresh to moderate Westerly by late afternoon.

Comments

Currently there is snow on most aspects, generally a bit patchy but improves with altitude.
