



Wind Slab

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Deposits of windslab will exist in steep wind sheltered locations such as sheltered gullies and on North-West through North to East aspects above 850 metres. Greatest accumulations will be around coire rims, gully tops, ridge flanks and sheltered hollows. Cornices will be fragile on these aspects also. Elsewhere the snowpack will continue to consolidate and be generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Very light snow showers overnight will affect slopes mainly above 850 metres, dry conditions are expected on Saturday. The freezing level will be around 1100 metres. Winds will be moderate to fresh generally East-South-Easterly.
