

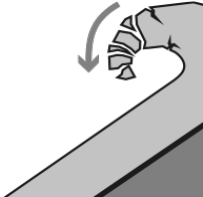

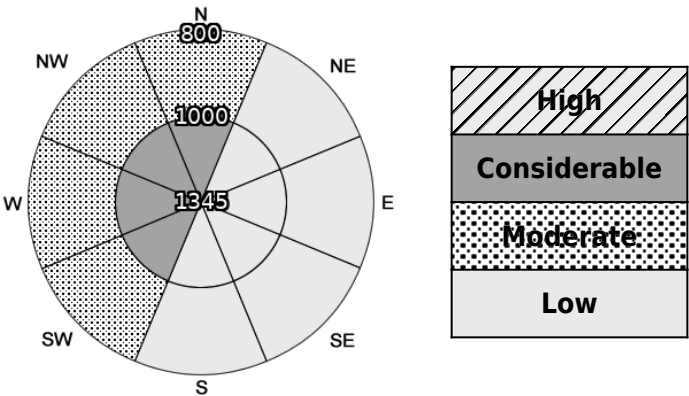
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh unstable windslab will develop through the period mainly on South-West through West to North aspects above 1000 metres with more localised deposits at lower elevations. Fragile cornices will develop above these aspects. Stability in the older snowpack will generally be good. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Gale force East-South-Easterly winds. Snow above around 600 metres, heaviest overnight. Freezing level around 900 metres.

Comments

Strong East-South-Easterly winds continuing for the next few days.
