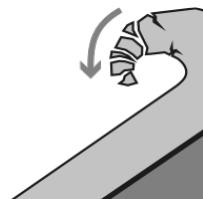



Wind Slab

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Many windward slopes will remain stable with a firm and icy surface in places. Fresh deposits of windslab will form through the day in steep wind sheltered locations such as sheltered gullies and steep slopes with a mainly South-West through West to Northerly aspect above 850 metres. Deposits are not expected to be extensive, corrie rims, ridge flanks and gully tops will be most affected. Other aspects may be affected through cross loading. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Some light snowfall will affect the area. Winds will be fresh to strong becoming generally Easterly. Summit temperatures will be around -2 degrees C.
