


Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Any snow areas on all aspects, will be hard icy and stable, with some softening of the snowpack below 900m. Greatest amounts are predominantly on North-West through North and East to Southerly aspects above 700m. Elsewhere hard stable snow is confined to gullies and patches. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds remain Easterly, fresh to strong in strength overnight but lessening to light by the afternoon. A dry day is once more expected. Freezing level around 900m.

Comments

The cold E airstream continues, the strong winds will lessen to provide a calmer day. Slightly milder conditions Sunday but colder again by Tuesday.
