



**Avalanche Hazard Forecast**

The snowpack will continue to very slowly consolidate. Area of dense and reasonably well bonded windslab will remain on sheltered West to North aspects above 900 metres. On other aspects above 900 metres the snowpack will be firm and icy. At lower levels it will continue to gently thaw. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Another generally dry day with strengthening South-Easterly winds. The freezing level will be around 900 metres.

**Comments**

Slip hazard on the firm, wind scoured snow surface at higher levels.
