




Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to consolidate and stability will be generally good. Very isolated and shallow areas of windslab will be present in sheltered locations mainly on South-West through West to North aspects above 950 metres. Some fragile cornices will be present, mainly above these aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be very strong Easterly winds. Mainly dry with isolated showers falling as snow above 300 metres. The freezing level will drop to around 400 metres.

Comments

In most locations the snowpack surface will be icy and firm.
