

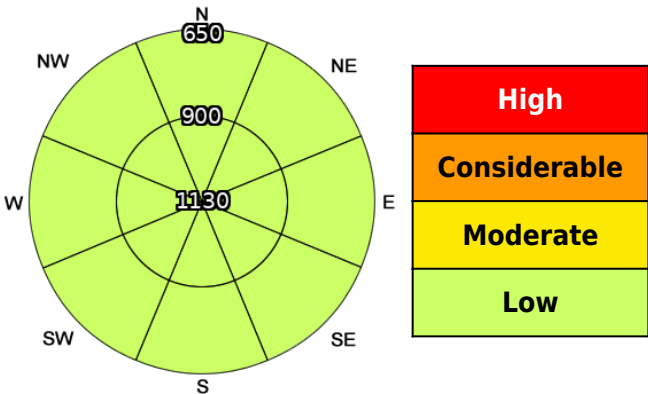

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected in the snowpack. Areas of well bonded windslab will remain on mainly wind sheltered West to North aspects above 900 metres. On other aspects, and below this altitude the snowpack will be shallow and firm. Stability will be good throughout. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

A dry but cloudy day with a freezing level of around 500 metres. Winds from the East.

Poor visibility and flat light expected at higher levels on Friday.
