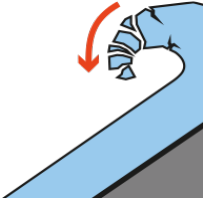

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 09/02/2026

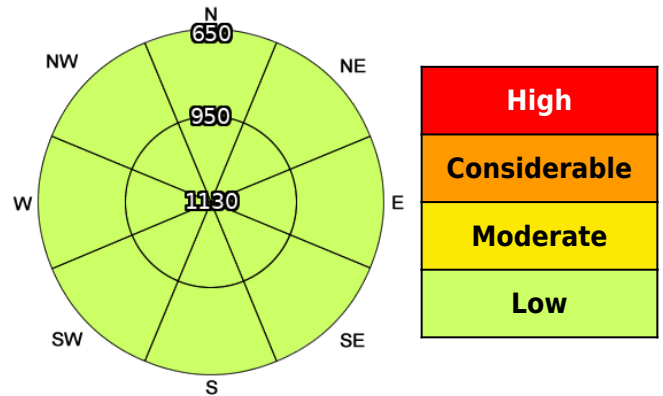
Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change. Good stability in most places. Some new moist well bonded windslab is possible on a few very steep West to North aspects above 1000m. Elsewhere the snowpack will be moist but generally well stabilised, though some localised minor wet surface snow instability may affect steeper recent lee slopes below 950m. Cornices expected to weaken. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Similar weather pattern to the previous 24 hours. A few sleety snow showers over summits with light rain at lower elevations. Freezing close to summits throughout. Light to moderate South East winds.

Some potential for falling ice from low altitude crags.
