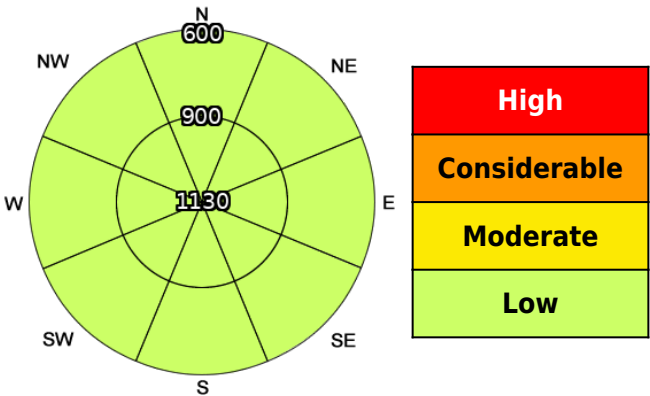
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will be mostly firm and icy with good stability all areas. Isolated accumulations of windslab and softer deposits will be present above 900 metres on South-West through West to North-West aspects. These will be generally shallow and not extensive. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Mostly dry with the freezing level around 400 metres. Fresh East-North-East winds will back North-North-West and steadily decrease to become moderate.

Comments

Cold North-Easterly airflow for the next couple of days. A slip or fall could have serious consequences due to hard snowpack and exposed rocks.
