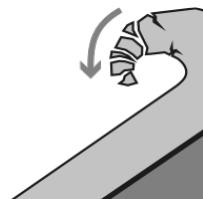



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Further deposits of unstable windslab will accumulate tonight and through the morning. Significant accumulations becoming more wide spread will be found in steep locations on mainly East to South aspects above 800 metres though other aspects and elevations will also be affected. Cornices will be fragile in these locations also. Areas exposed to the wind will be firm and generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Fresh to strong North-Westerly winds this evening with further snowfall above 250 metres. Snow showers to lower elevations for the remainder of the night and through the morning as the Northerly winds ease. Dryer in the afternoon with light to moderate winds.
