




Avalanche Hazard Forecast

Unstable windslab will persist mainly on North to East aspects above 900 metres. Fresh unstable windslab will also develop, mainly overnight, on South-East to South-West aspects above 900 metres. At lower elevations stability will be better. Recently formed cornices will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Strong North-Westerly winds in the evening veer to the North-North-East and then ease during the day. Snow showers in the evening followed by a dry day. Freezing level around 300 metres.
