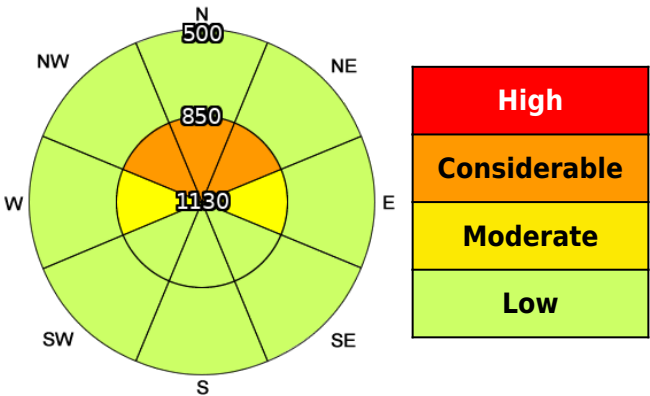

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh windslab accumulations will develop in wind-sheltered locations due to snow redistribution. Existing weaknesses will also persist. Areas most affected will be West through North to East aspects above 850 metres. Fragile cornices will develop above Northerly aspects. Generally good stability elsewhere with wind exposed locations being firm and icy. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

A dry period with the freezing level around 250 metres overnight, rising to 450 metres during the day. Fresh, South-Easterly winds will increase through Tuesday night to reach gale force by dawn.

Comments

High pressure will be replaced on Thursday by a Westerly airflow bringing more unsettled conditions.
