




#### Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow




Cornices

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised wet snow instability on steep North to East aspects above 950m. Wet, weak and collapse prone cornices over some of these locations. Elsewhere the snowpack will be wet or moist but generally well stabilised. Some potential for minor full depth avalanches from very steep snow laden crags. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Wet overnight then showery during the day. Mild at all altitudes throughout.

#### Comments

Falling rocks and ice additional objective hazard during the current mild, wet conditions.
