



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 24/02/2026

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snow cover will continue to thaw but will remain generally well bonded. Greatest amounts will be found on South-West through North-West to North-East aspects above 600 metres. Any remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will rise well above the summits for this forecasted period. Occasional rain, mainly overnight and in the afternoon. Near gale winds, South-South-West in the morning, backing South in the afternoon.
