



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 28/02/2026

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Colder conditions will maintain a consolidated snowpack. During the morning the surface layer will be frozen, firm and icy on all aspects some softening may take place after midday. Deepest snow amounts will exist on North-West through North to Easterly aspects above 850 metres other aspects will have lesser amounts. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will be around 700 metres, it is expected to be dry and clear, maybe even sunny. Winds will be light Southerly at first, strengthening through the day becoming moderate or strong.

Comments

The snowpack surface is likely to be firm and icy with serious consequences in the likelihood of a slip or a slide.
