

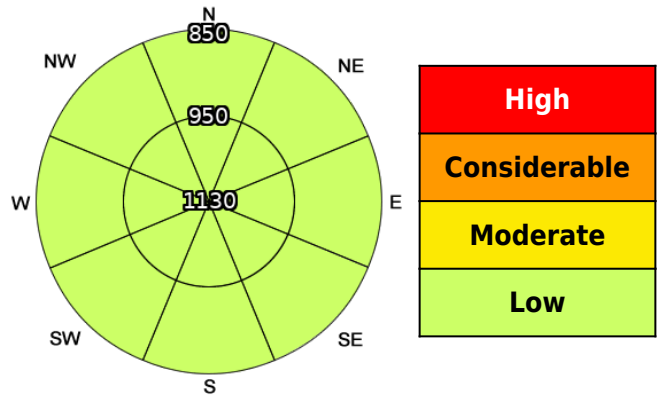

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 04/03/2026

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will have good stability throughout. It will remain firm and icy overnight, then slowly start to soften during the daytime. Snow cover is now mostly confined to North-West through North to Easterly aspects above 850 metres, with only patches remaining below this level, which will continue to thaw throughout Wednesday. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Southerly winds will increase through Tuesday night to become very strong. Light rain is expected during the day with the freezing level remaining well above the summits.

Comments

Although the snow will start to slowly soften throughout daylight hours, there is still potential for a slip or fall to have serious consequences. Possibility of rock and ice fall from the cliffs during Wednesday daytime.
