

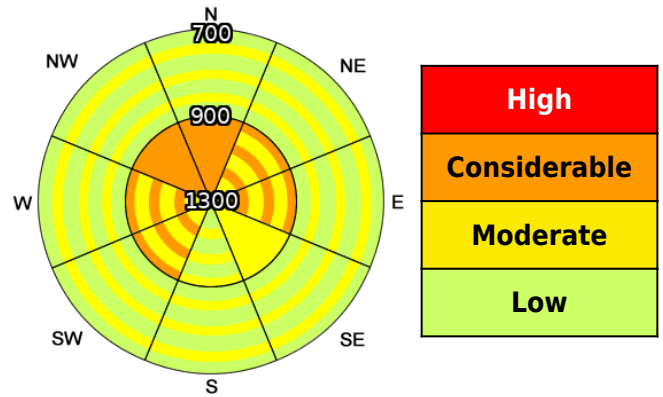

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 04/03/2026

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain well bonded, firm and stable. Largest areas will remain on North-West through North to East aspects above 900 metres, snow cover will be more patchy elsewhere. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

After a dry night rain will develop at all levels during the day. The freezing level will rise above all summits by dawn with Southerly winds increasing in strength to become strong during daylight hours.

Comments

Despite the rising temperatures and rain the snow surface is likely to be reasonably firm with potential for serious consequences in the event of a trip or slip.
