
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Moderately bonded windslab will be present in wind sheltered locations on North-West through North to East aspects above 900 metres. Gully tops and steep slopes under corrie rims will be worst affected. Exposed locations will be scoured and icy in places. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

No precipitation forecast. Moderate to fresh South, then South-South-Westerly winds. Poorly defined freezing level, cooler overnight then 900 rising to 1200 metres, maybe higher later.

Comments

Caution required when localised unstable windslab present. Icy conditions underfoot in exposed locations.
