

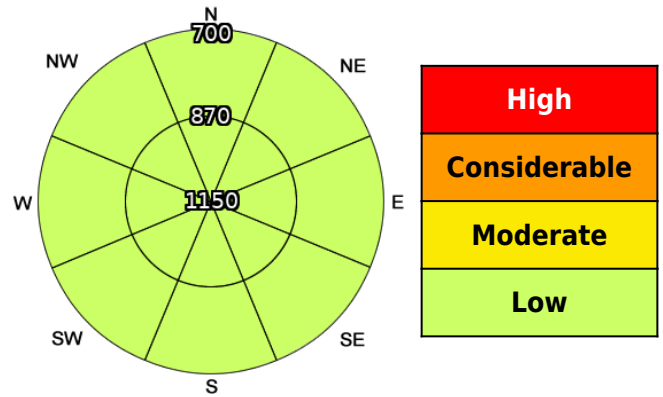

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 09/03/2026

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The remaining snowpack will continue to slowly thaw and diminish at all elevations becoming increasingly soft and wet. Stability will be generally good. Largest continuous snow areas will be on North-West through North to East aspects above around 870 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Mainly dry overnight and through the morning. A period of patchy rain around the middle of the day only falling as sleet on the highest summits. Southerly winds will be fresh to strong.

Comments

Icy patches remain with potential for very consequential slips and trips.

Showery on Tuesday with wintery conditions on the summits.
