



**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 09/03/2026**

**Avalanche Problems**

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The patchy snowpack will remain well bonded and stable in all locations. Fresh snow accumulations on the higher summits are not expected to be significant. Greatest snow cover will be on North-West through North to East aspects above 750 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

A strong Southerly wind eases and veers to the South-West in the afternoon. Showers will mostly fall as rain with sleet or wet snow only on the higher summits. The freezing level will drop from above the summits to around 1000 metres by the end of the period.
