


## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 10/03/2026


#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Snowpack stability will be generally good in all locations. In deep accumulations some localised instabilities will persist on very steep North and North-East aspects above 1000 meters but these will not be extensive. At higher elevations, the snowpack will firm up overnight before softening during the day. Snow loss will continue at lower elevations. Any remaining cornices will remain a hazard. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

A dusting of fresh overnight snow above 1000 metres will clear to leave a dry day. Strong South-South-Westerly winds will increase through the day backing South. The freezing level will be around 1000 metres overnight rising above summit height in the afternoon.
