

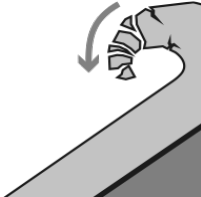

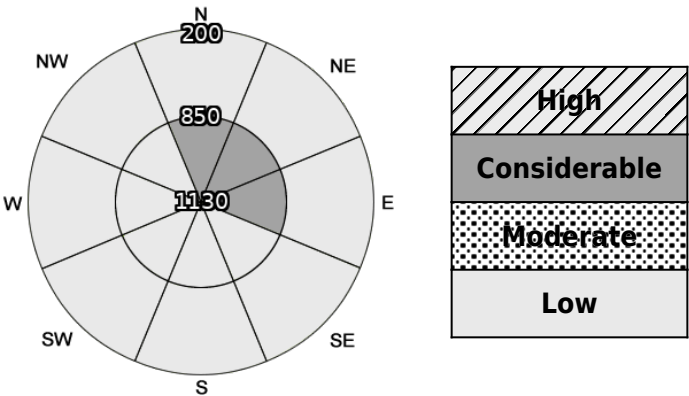
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Unstable windslab will continue to develop overnight and during the day becoming more widespread and deeper on Northerly to Easterly aspects above 850 metres. Coire rims, headwalls and gullies especially affected. Cornices will also build above same aspects with collapse possible. Below 850m and elsewhere new snow will mostly lie on bare ground and be stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds gale force South-Westerly overnight veering West-South-West during the day but remaining strong. Persistent snow fall throughout the forecast period above 200m overnight then above 500m or so as the freezing level rises slightly.
