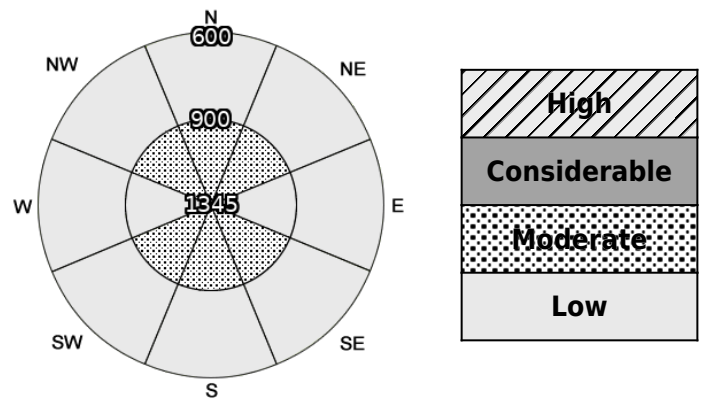
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised areas of unstable windslab will develop at the start of the period on South-East to South-West aspects and in the afternoon on North-West to North East aspects above 900 metres. The older snowpack will refreeze and have good stability. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Fresh Northerly winds become light early in the morning, veering to the South and becoming strong during the day. Snow showers in the evening and afternoon, mainly dry in between. The freezing level will drop to 500 metres overnight, rising to 800 metres in the afternoon.

Comments

Weather outlook is for fairly cold and unsettled conditions.
