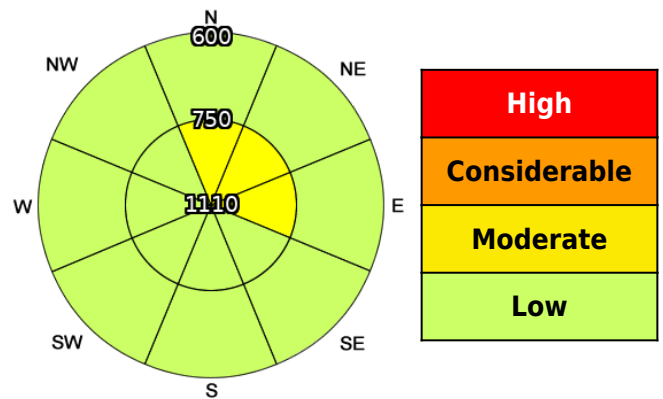
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised deposits of fresh windslab will develop through the forecast period. Steep wind sheltered locations on North to East aspects above 750 metres will be most affected with some redistribution onto Westerly aspects from mid afternoon, however on Westerly aspects new deposits will overlie bare ground. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers throughout the period becoming more frequent towards the end of the afternoon. The freezing level will rise from around 400 metres to 600 metres. Strong West-South-Westerly winds overnight decreasing and becoming moderate Southerly during the day and backing South-Easterly increasing significantly from mid afternoon.

Comments

Storm Dave will bring storm force winds overnight Saturday into Sunday.
