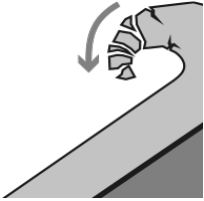

**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 07/04/2026**

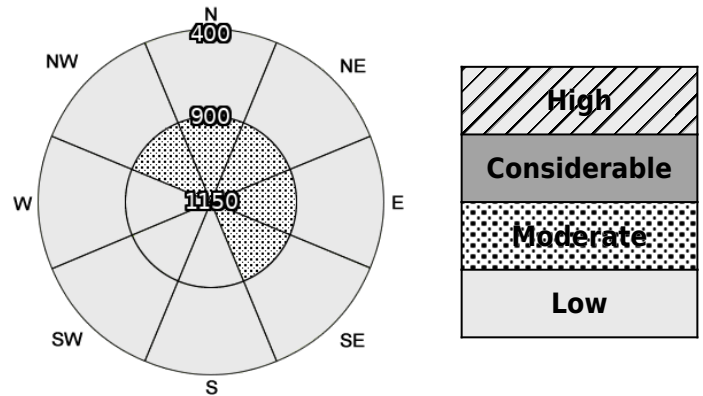
**Avalanche Problems**

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will slowly consolidate as milder conditions take effect but pockets of windslab will persist. Greatest instabilities will be mainly on North-West through North to East aspects above 900 meters. Cornices above similar aspects will become unstable and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Overnight frost possible but the freezing level will generally be well above the summits. A mainly dry day with some light rain at the end of the period. Winds will generally be strong South-Easterly.
